- the thesis in electronic form (PDF),
- the certificate or diploma (the exam must be fully completed between 1 August 2023 and 31 July 2025),
- the curriculum vitae/academic career (if not included in the thesis) with signature and date and
- the reviews or assessments, provided the reviewers agree. If no reviews can be attached, a laudatio by the supervisor is required.
